As a real shoe fetishist, he's stretching the heels till 10 cm, he's designing tight shapes and he's lining the shoes' interior with delicate real deer skin. And erases his own name: there's no logo, no griffe, no show-off brands or artefacts. "My" woman doesn't buy a name, he says, and that ridiculous external mark of social recognition is not my cup of tea".
